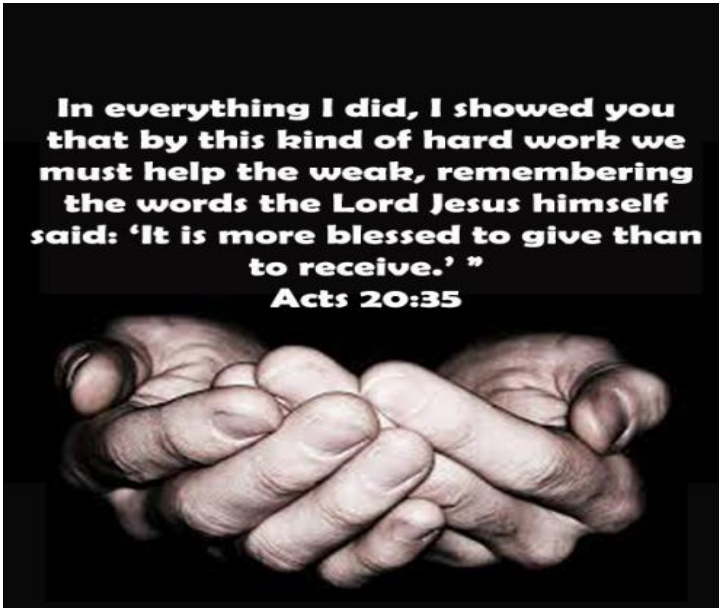

- Students will be dismissed from school at 2pm.

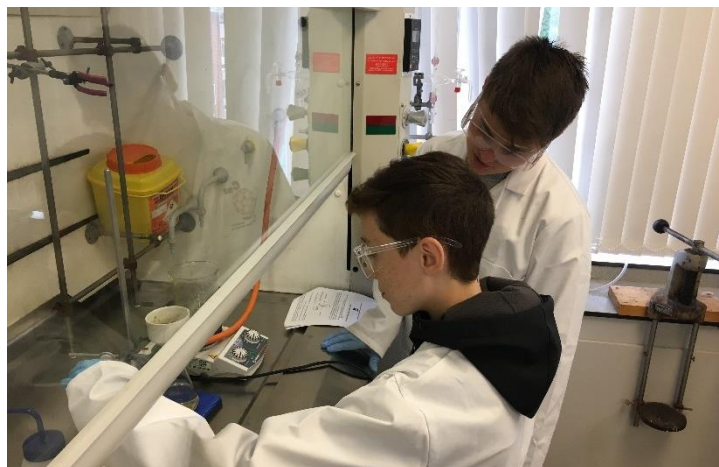

MAGT Science Trip



Last week Miss Montoya took 4 Year 9 MAGT Chemists to Sussex University to enjoy an extension day of Chemistry based experiments organised by the Salter's Festival of Chemistry. The

pupils were tasked with quantifying the purity of tablets using fluorescent markers that they themselves prepared using specialist equipment. They had to wear protective gear whilst working within the labs working inside fume cupboards and in the dark. As always our pupils were wonderful ambassadors for the school and came away with not only a greater understanding of how to work in a real lab but they were also given a small momento of 'Chemistry Lego' (Molymods).

The cost of the tickets are as follows: **£5 per adult and £2.50 for Under 12s, with entry being free for Under 5s**. Tickets will be available to purchase via scopay and the school office from Monday 10th July until 3pm Monday 17th July. Please note – ticket sales in person will only be possible at break, lunch times or after school, and office staff are only able to accept payments by cheque or in the correct change. Online sales may be closed sooner than Monday 17th July, should it appear that the event will sell out. We will communicate home if this is the case. Physical tickets for the Showcase will be distributed to students via their tutor on Tuesday 18th July. It will not be possible to collect tickets prior to this.

Families and adult friends of students at King's will be very welcome. However, on this occasion, we will not

be able to cater for student groups from other secondary schools. Tickets are based on a first come first served basis, and to ensure that access to the event is fair for all, there will be a strict limit of four tickets per purchase, including concessions. **Tickets will not be available on the night.** There is very limited parking available, and therefore we would ask that drivers respect the properties of our neighbours and park with consideration.

The Showcase will feature a selection of singing, dancing, drama and musical acts and there will also be a chance to view a display of our students' exceptional Art work. Refreshments will be available during a short interval and the evening will conclude by 9pm. We look forward to seeing you there.

Sports Day



As you know, this year we will be holding our Sports Day at the Withdean Stadium for the first time. We appreciate that there have been a number of changes regarding the logistical

arrangements for this day; we apologise for this and we have learnt lessons for next year! Please find a timetable for the day below with the final arrangements. You are reminded that this is a school day and attendance is compulsory for all students. Students should bring packed lunches and drinks for the day, as well as suncream and hats if the weather is hot.

- 8.30am - All students to arrive in school as normal, dressed in PE kit. Students may wear

accessories in their house colours but should not wear face paint. Students will go to tutor bases to register

- 8.45am - All students involved in field events will travel to the Withdean Stadium by coach. Students involved in rounders will go up to the school field. Students involved in benchball will go to the school playground
- 10.30am - All students involved in benchball will travel to the Withdean Stadium by coach
- 11.45am - All students involved in rounders will travel to the Withdean Stadium by coach
- 12.30pm - All students will be involved in track events at the Withdean Stadium
- 2.30pm Sports Day ends. Students may depart directly from the Stadium with consent, others will be bussed back to school.

All students must travel to the Withdean Stadium from school by coach. Students may depart the Withdean Stadium directly if we have received parental consent for this. If you have previously sent in a consent slip we will take this as your consent. If you haven't yet given consent and would like your child to depart directly from the Withdean Stadium please notify us by emailing admin@kingsschoolhove.org.uk Please note that students will return to school by coach in two trips. The first trip is expected back in school for approximately 3pm. The second trip will arrive back in school between 3.30pm and 4.00pm. It will not be possible for us to notify you in advance which trip your child will be on but students will be allowed to use mobile phones to contact parents on the day.
