


Headteacher's Update





Thank you for your patience whilst we worked hard to resolve issues with Innovate, our new catering company. You are now able to view what your child has purchased each day at the canteen on Parentpay. We are working with Innovate to re-establish a maximum daily spending limit of £6, we are hopeful this will be in place by the end of September. In the meantime, please remind your children what their own spending limit is each day. The ELSA study, led by the University of Birmingham, is screening children, aged 3-13 years to find out their risk of developing type 1 diabetes. This is a simple finger stick blood test, that can be done at home or in the community.

ELSA is working with Sussex Community NHS Foundation Trust (SCFT) who will be holding sessions to carry out finger stick tests if you prefer not to do it at home.
